

# September News and Greetings from Marianne Overton MBE

## Lincolnshire County Council LCC North Kesteven District Council NKDC

This is my personal newsletter to inform you what I am doing on your behalf and to keep in touch with you.

### Dear Friends and Colleagues,

I hope you are well and avoided the worst of the extreme weather events. (I measured 50mm of rain in about an hour!) Thanks to local volunteers, Parish Council and our highways teams for their support in prompt temporary arrangements, pending further works. County Council clear 185,000 gullies annually. They have received £50m to tackle coastal and surface flooding, so now is a good time to press ahead!





### Highways

The Highways Community Team are working in our area over August and the first part of September, doing lots of smaller jobs, such as fixing signs, restoring verges and cutting back vegetation of paths. The pothole team is continuing using "Fixmystreet" for jobs. Road surfacing, speed limits and yellow lines need wider support to get into the program. Thanks to the Parish Councils for working diligently with me on your behalf.

#### **Grants for Businesses**

I am glad to say that North Kesteven distributed all our over-subscribed £1.03m discretionary fund. A new "Recovery Grant" of up to £3,000 opens from September for new Covid-related projects. #### Have we Councillors been busy during Covid?

Yes! At NKDC there are 22 Independents and 21 "NK Administration", previously named Conservative. The 22 Independents are 18 in the "NK Independents (Lincolnshire Independents and Independents)" and four Ione. Although formal meetings were fewer with fewer members on them, we councillors kept working. as hard as we could for our residents.

#### **Community Work**

Although in lockdown, with reduced committees, we have been undaunted. Our members have been deeply engaged in their communities, setting up and supporting

#### **Boundary Commission at NKDC**

Led by ClIrs Robert Oates and David Suiter, Independents worked solidly cross-party to produce the best possible NKDC plan and a well-evidenced alternative from the Independents. The latest plan out, for consultation until October 19<sup>th</sup> now includes some, but not all of our suggestions. We are calling for further evidence to support our option that assists the natural cohesion of our communities. #### Standards

#### **Climate Change**

As we see more extreme weather events, we have made a start on tackling climate change nationally and locally. Thank you. Our councillors have taken a lead and NKDC's new Action Plan is on the NKDC website. Thanks for your contributions and comments welcome.

#### **Sweeping Planning Changes**

#### Elections

Working with the Independent Network we have lobbied central government to have local elections at polling stations with social distancing in May 2021, as well as the usual postal vote option.

#### Working with Ministers on Covid and on the EU

As national Leader of the Independent Group of 2,500 councillors, Cllr Marianne Overton MBE is working on getting key issues to the ministers in a series of meetings on line.

On tackling Covid 19, topics have included funding councils sufficiently so we can be there to assist with the recovery, making sure care homes and carers could access PPE, as well as the NHS, localising food deliveries in lockdown, localising test and trace putting Councils at the heart of our response. A new £500K is just announced.

Lincolnshire has now tested 300,000 people and successfully traced almost 90pc of contacts.

#### Leaving the EU

Work continues on our ministerial board looking at how the government could mitigate the impacts of leaving the EU without a deal. Now is the last opportunity to comment on the basic plan for up to 6,000 dwellings at the big Bracebridge Heath development, called the Lincoln SE Quarter. These are plans drawn up by the Council on what it wants the developer to submit. It includes its own retail area, 7ha of industry, 2x3 form entry primary schools and a secondary school for 640 pupils, which is below the normal size deemed practical. Fly-tipping has worsened, so please keep reporting. NKDC will prosecute and have cameras. The County Council on-line waste booking system works well.

National Work: In case you missed it with August!

Meetings with ministers and leading Councillors and Mayors from across the country this month, have focussed on funding for council services, getting culture and tourism up and running, and supporting retail and transport. I invite 32 Independent group Council Leaders to meet fortnightly and other national meetings have focussed on the fire safety, and devolution of powers to our councils.

The government promised devolution of powers and money to local government, but the idea of requiring costly and time-consuming reorganisation of our councils, was not in the manifesto. If we were to reorganise it would have to be worth it, with substantial powers and matching funding. Otherwise it may be a costly distraction when we have our backs to the wall and should be focussing on the recovery from covid.

#### Lincolnshire Reorganisation?

In Lincolnshire, our Councils already make significant savings by joint working and shared services and still keeping our identity and strong sense of democratic accountability to you, our residents.

The County Council Leader has written to government in readiness to reorganise, as before, which, last time, I fought against, successfully with colleagues. A very large organisation is often unwieldly and hard for residents to influence. The June monthly poll showed that 87% of people were satisfied or very satisfied with their local Council. I am not sure what the figure would be for national government.
