## UPDATED DATES: Cereals Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June - Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> July

## CEREALS 2021 - Boothby Heath Farm, B1202 Heath Lane, Lincolnshire. Wodnesday 9th - Thursday 10th June (07:00 – 18:00).

Lincolnshire County Council has issued Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders authorising the operation of one-way systems, road closures and no waiting restrictions for the event.

The traffic plan has changed from that used in previous years, in that the Heath Road Access gates and Rose Cottage Lane will not form part of the Traffic Plan for 2021. All traffic on event days, will access from the A607 along the B1202 as before. Traffic from the A15 northbound will access via a left turn at Metheringham Heath Lane Crossroads and immediately turn right into the East Car Park, Traffic traveling southbound down the A15 will turn right at B1178 (Tower Lane) then turn left onto the A607 southbound at Harmston Crossroads towards Boothby Graffoe, then turn left on the B1202 and then left onto the signed farm drive that leads to the Event Car Parks.

Site Build Up and Break Down vehicles in the pre- and post-event period will only access the site from the A15 onto the B1202 at Metheringham Heath Lane Crossroads and into site.

There will be Traffic Management Systems and Temporary Route Signs in place in the surrounding area and pre-event advisory signs for commuting traffic to plan their journeys for the Build Up, the Event itself for two days and Break Down. We will also have in place, 3 sets of temporary traffic lights within the surrounding area to ensure the flow of traffic. We would like to highlight the following:

- Traffic Routes for Cereals: for the Build Up and Breakdown period (except Thursday 10th) all 'Contractor' vehicles will be routed to the site using the A15 (from north and south) at Metheringham Heath Lane Crossroads. All visitor traffic on event days will be routed to the site using via the A15 and A607. On Thursday 10th, contractors' vehicles arriving after 1300hrs will be signed in via the A607 Boothby Graffoe.
- B1202 Heath Lane, Boothby Graffoe: Road Closure and One Way to assist with 'Build Up' this road will be closed to normal traffic from 00:01 on Monday 7th June. The closure will extend through the two days of the event and remain in place until 1700 on Saturday 12th June to assist with 'Break Down'. Cereals Site Traffic during 'Build Up' and 'Break Down' which will include large articulated vehicle transporters entering and leaving via the A15 junction. During the two days of the event this road will be used for Visitors to enter and exit the car parks using the A607 junction and one-way systems will be implemented between Rose Cottage Lane to the Cereals site for all Car Parks. (AM Inbound) & PM Outbound will operate between the A15 and East Car Park Gate.
- Blacksmith Lane, Boothby Graffoe: Road Closure for the two days of the event Blacksmith Lane, Boothby Graffoe, will be closed at the junction with A607 Lincoln / Grantham Road and no traffic will be able to exit or enter Blacksmith Lane at this junction. This closure will be implemented at 05:00 and removed at 21:00 each day. The alternative route from or to the A607 is to use Main Street in Boothby Graffoe.
- B1202 Metheringham Heath Lane, Metheringham: Road Closure for the two days of the event the B1202 Metheringham Heath Lane will be closed at the junction with the A15 Lincoln / Sleaford Road and no traffic will be able to exit or enter Metheringham Heath Lane at this junction. This closure will be implemented at 05:00 and removed at 21:00 each day and an alternative route from or to the A15 will be signed.

Access will be facilitated for residents located off the B1202 Metheringham Heath Lane who should enter from, and exit to, the direction of Metheringham.

**Temporary traffic signals** will be in place for the two days of the event and will only be in operation when deemed necessary at the following locations:

At the junction of A607 Lincoln / Grantham Road and B1202 Heath Lane at Boothby Graffoe. These may be supplemented by using a Stop / Go system. These may be operated during the Inbound period (06:00 - 12:00) and will be operated during the Outbound period (14:00 - 20:00) in conjunction with the one-way system on the B1202.

At the turning from Pottersgate Road onto the A607 at Wellingore / Navenby, during the Inbound period (06:00 - 12:00).

At the A15 junction with B1202 Heath Lane during the Outbound period (14:00 – 20:00).

**No Waiting Restrictions, Navenby: A607** – for the two days of the event 'No Waiting' cones will be deployed at 0600 on the  $9^{th}$  and be removed at 2000 on the 10th to indicate that No Waiting restrictions apply on the A607 through Navenby. This is to assist with the flow of traffic and reduce congestion within the village.

• **Delays on approach roads** may be experienced during the Inbound and Outbound peak periods of the show and for which we apologise for any inconvenience this causes.
