FLYTIPPING AND NHOW TO STOP IT

If you follow NKDC's social media channels (if not, why not?) you may have seen some recent successes in prosecuting fly tippets. NK always seek to punish fly tippers, but the householders can also be fined if waste is traced back to them.

How you can avoid this? It's simple, don't pass your waste onto an unlicensed operator.

Make sure you can show you took "reasonable care". Don't give waste to anyone who doesn't have a waste carriers license. You can check this by asking them to show you their license, and checking they are registered with the Environmental Agency. A legitimate waste carrier will have no problem providing this information.

Take photos on license.

Don't pay cash- pay by bank transfer or Pay Pal so you have a trail to the waste carrier. If they will only take cash they are probably not legitimate.

EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME

The deadline for the EU Settlement Scheme is fast approaching- applications must be in by 30th June 2021.

Residents who are an EU, EEA, or Swiss Citizen and their family can apply to the EU Settlement Scheme to continue living in the UK after 30th June 2021. They can also apply if they're the family member of an eligible person of Northern Ireland.

The EEA includes the EU countries and also Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway. They may be able to stay in the UK without applying - for example, if they're and Irish citizen or have indefinite leave to remain.
