### Messages From Our Coordinators:

#### Stephanie Marwood - West Lindsey and Lincoln

Over the summer I've been out in the communities across my patch and have consulted residents on local issues and the new Police and Crime Plan. I've attended events which aim to bring organisations together who share the same ambition for an area and can work together to make the positive changes.

From 1<sup>st</sup> November I will be engaging with residents about the Annual Precept Survey as we would like as many people as possible to take part. I'll also be attending events including the LALC AGM, Freshers Week and the Faces to Names Event to share Force initiatives, raise awareness of the Team and ask residents about local issues. I'll continue to work closely with the NPT's in Lincoln and West Lindsey and use the information I receive to inform their priorities.

#### Alan Osborne - Boston and South Holland

At last, I have been able to get out and about more now that restrictions have started to lift and as a result have been engaging with the public at events in Monk House Park, Spalding, the Skate Jam in Boston as well as the very successful Mutual Gain event in Long Sutton. In addition, I have been out consulting people on their views on the PCC's next Police and Crime plan. In Boston I have been engaged with the YMCA who are setting up the Good Neighbourhood Scheme, have established links with the local deaf/hard of hearing group and the Restore church around their work with the homeless. I continue to attend the NPT's priority setting meetings, Boston and South Holland Community Alcohol Partnership meetings and various other events such as the Youth Commission, Boston Neighbourhood Action Group, Veterans group and Ageing Friendly Communities.

#### Roisin Mullee - East Lindsey

It has been great really great getting out and about across East Lindsey. Engaging with the residents on all things community safety. I have met with members of the only Lincolnshire AWOC (Ageing Without Children) Group as well as the Winthorpe Community Partnership discussing ideas of how we can work together in order to make people feel safer and enjoy living in East Lindsey. I taken on the co-ordination of the Skegness Community Alcohol Partnership with a drive to get more partners on board. I continue to work closely with the local NPTS across the district and attend Neighbourhood Priority Setting Meetings to feedback directly any views collated from the community.

#### Maisie McMahon - North and South Kesteven

I have now been in post for Safer Together Coordinator for North and South Kesteven for the Office of Police and Crime for 9 Months now.

The lifting of the COVID restrictions has meant that I have been able to go out and engage with my local neighbourhood policing teams as well as community groups, residents, and partners. It has been great to finally meet people face to face and properly introduce myself. Community safety has been the focus, making sure that you are given a say in what goes on in your community.

I have taken part in some events this quarter, you may have seen me at RAF Digby Family Day, Sleaford Fire and Rescue Open Day, Mutual Gain Sleaford World Café Event.

I have been involved in meetings such as the Neighbourhood Policing Priority Setting Meetings, North Kesteven Community Awards Judging Panel, Community Development Meetings for North Kesteven.
