FOSSE GREEN ENERGY

The schematic plan shows the broad area of the solar park (it is understood that this area is to be proposed to accommodate solar panels, converters, battery storage and landscape/biodiversity mitigation) along with a number of cable route options to a proposed new National Grid substation in the vicinity of the A15 close to Ashby de la Launde.

The wards affected are:

Bassingham Rural

Witham St Hughes and Swinderby

Navenby and Brant Broughton

Ashby de la Launde, Digby and Scopwick

Skellingthorpe and Doddington (lies adjacent to the site only around Tunman Wood)

The promoter has registered their proposal with the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP). As an NSIP the Council (along with the County Council) are prescribed a role as a host authority where there is an expectation for NKDC to assist the promoter by providing information and guidance but also to scrutinise and challenge their proposal. Ultimately the decision is taken by the relevant Secretary of State. A non-statutory consultation is proposed in June and July, and it is anticipated that the promoter will be seeking a Scoping Opinion from PINS for Environmental impact Assessment at broadly the same time.

This new proposal is the fourth solar energy NSIP live wholly in the district, the others being Heckington Fen, and Springwell Solar Beacon Reservoir NKDC also have the proposal from Anglian Water for the Lincolnshire Reservoir that is registered as a water based NSIP.

SOLOR PANEL INSTALLATION AT COUNCIL OFFICES SET TO CUT TONNES OF CARBON

Installation of 195 solar panels at the North Kesteven District Council's offices has now been completed, making a significant contribution to the councils aim of achieving net zero carbon emissions by 2030.

The installation will reduce the Councils electricity bill by 21% and save over 14 tonnes of CO2 per year.

The solar panels installed on the Kesteven Street building came at a cost of £152,000,drawn from the Council's Invest to Save reserve – a fund specifically ear-marked for projects that reduce the Councils long term overheads.
