Crumbling Bubble concrete (RAAC)

More than a hundred schools, colleges and nurseries have had to close immediately because they are made with reinforced, autoclaved, aerated concrete. Our County Council has reviewed of all Local Authority schools, and found them clear. Currently, no Lincolnshire Schools are affected for the new term.

Homes for Ukrainians

Since March 2022, more than 1,350 Ukrainians have made Lincolnshire their temporary home under the Homes for Ukraine scheme. Sponsors receive £350 a month during the first 12 months of your guests' stay. This increases to £500 once your guest has been in the UK for 12 months, in order to help sponsors who are able to continue hosting for longer, up to a maximum of 2 years. Government Info is here. The Lancaster Gateway Project

The Lancaster Bomber Sculture is progressing with the base in place and the main frame done. Timmins at Cainby Corner are now doing the rear section as a labour of love. Just £80,000 is needed to buy the remainder of the steel for them to complete the works.

Your View...

On Closing Railway Ticket Offices

It is proposed to close rail station ticket offices, including Sleaford and Grantham. Many of us have responded, as train travellers, concerned at the reduction of service and care for passengers who should have equal access to the train service. <u>TicketOffice.LNER@Transportfocus.org.uk</u>

A motion was raised in Parliament and we shall be asking the Council to support our residents too.

"That this House notes with concern the planned mass closure of rail ticket offices, leaving many of over 1000 train stations unstaffed; recognises that railway ticket office staff are a vital resource for many passengers who might struggle to manage online booking processes and for the security of children, women, disabled and other vulnerable passengers on the rail network; further notes that station staff including ticket office staff are essential to the smooth running of the rail network; agrees with the Royal National Institute for the Blind that the closures would be hugely detrimental to the blind and partially sighted; notes that the future of ticket offices is a key item in the ongoing rail worker dispute; and therefore calls on the Secretary of State for Transport to reject The Rail Delivery Group's proposals in full."

On Huge Solar Panel Arrays

We have supported applications of fields, especially when connected to the industry they serve. Our new Local Plan for Central Lincolnshire, passed in April 2023 requires new developments to demonstrate how they are meeting our target of net zero emissions, which is having a dramatically positive effect on the energy- saving standards of new buildings. We also have many thousands of acres of south-facing commercial rooves which could have solar panels added. Floating offshore turbines are also going ahead in a dramatic way.

A significant influx of very large solar panel developments covering miles of farmland, concentrated around connections near Navenby is more worrying. Fosse Green proposed below the cliff edge and Springwell on the heath together around 7,000 acres. Lincolnshire currently has proposals for around 35,000 acres of solar panels, over 50 square miles. That is a lot of food we would not be growing. Even at say, 5 tons/acre, that is 175,000 tons of wheat we would need to get from somewhere.

We have a second meeting booked for Parish Councils and guests on September 12th at Thorpe on the Hill 7pm. There will be a public consultation and we aim to run a public meeting to ensure local people are informed.
