
This is my personal newsletter to let you know what I am doing on your behalf and to keep in touch with you. Let me know if I can help with anything.

Elections

The Police and Crime Commissioner "oversees" the police force. In Lincolnshire there was no change as Marc Jones was re-elected for his third term on just over a third of the votes (37%). Labour Michael Hodder was second with just under a third of the votes. (30%) Turnout was less than 20%. The area covers seven MP constituencies - and a Mayoral constituency would add four more – huge.

Local Elections

Nationally, it has been a fantastic election for Independents and Greens, who both increased by 69% in the 107 Councils up for election. Together, the Local Government Association Independent Group won 457 seats, an increase of 184 councillors, on a par with Labour.



In **Grantham**, after a long battle to get the right to have a Council for the town, Independents have now swept the board with 18 out of 22 members. Independents took the leadership of the District Council last year, bringing a powerful change, attracting new voices, fuelled by the fervour of public support and laying the groundwork for a bottom-up change of approach. In Lincoln, we supported Ashley Delaney (28), an inspiring young man. **Over 40 councils** in England and Wales are already led by Independent, Green and Plaid Cymru Councillors, part of the Independent Group of the Local Government Association and the Independent Network, which I lead. This year, the Network ran a "Be a Councillor" national programme to find and support new candidates and current councillors.

I meet with Independent, Green and Plaid leaders fortnightly and visit their councils. There I find a greater effort to connect with the public and significant changes to match local needs. For example in planning, in the way climate change is tackled, in local services, in civility, and working closely with communities to create lively, prosperous and environmentally friendly places to live.

Helping Businesses go greener!

NKDC has grants for installing low carbon heating systems and much more. Have a look <u>here</u> for useful webinars on sustainability and marketing with <u>social media</u>.

The **Rural Business Grant** supports businesses to develop new products and facilities that will be of wider benefit to the local economy. The grant will support capital investments only and sustainable investments will be prioritised. The minimum grant is £5,000 with some match funding required. Check if you are eligible. More info can be found <u>here</u>.

The **Small Business Grant** will be used to facilitate growth and expansion of local micro businesses or those that are seeking to relocate to North Kesteven. This fund offers grants of up to 40% of eligible costs, meaning match funding of 60% is required. Grants are available from ± 500 to a maximum of $\pm 5,000$, with a minimum project cost of $\pm 1,250$. More info can be found <u>here</u>.

Improving our local roads ...

I was pleased to get a good attendance at the public meeting in Bassingham last month with Senior Highways Officer, Richard Fenwick. Thank you residents for your brilliant support in raising our local issues. We pressed the officer to continue holding the contractors to account, paying on potholes actually repaired properly, but being prepared to pay on nearby deep holes repaired at the same time.

The officer also agered that the most cost effective solution was for an early and thorough repair of whole sections of road, as seen now on a good number of our rural roads. The budget has been increased for highways and flooding, which remains important with current work.

Facing up to Big Solar Industry

The huge scale of industrial developments continues to be a significant battle with unlimited applications coming in – thousands of acres of farmland in Lincolnshire right now with many new pylons. We have 7,000 acres in the two applications of Springwell and Fosse Green, below and above the cliff edge, all connecting to a new electricity substation at Navenby. Navenby Parish is 2,110 acres, running from the Brant to the A15. These two nearby proposals cover more than three times the whole of it.

An application for the power station at 'Wind Pump Farm", Green Man Road, **Navenby** has come in for a scoping opinion, fundamentally seeking agreement on the criteria to be assessed. The application is for 400MW of battery storage in 324 units, transformers, substation, control room etc. It is on agricultural land 1km from Navenby. Application is <u>here.</u> Navenby Parish Council and I are seeking your views. The public meeting held in April in Bassingham was 90% against, with three abstentions.

Letter from the Minister

Cllr Peter Overton put a motion to full Council at NKDC, calling on the Council to seek better planning on solar industries. We called for a sequential test and a maximum appropriate amount, rather than being the dumping ground for the whole country. The Council agreed, wrote to the Minister, who replied. There have also been two debates in Parliament, led by our MP's calling for better control on the scale of the developments on farmland in Lincolnshire.

Emperor's New Clothes – "Devo Deal"

In a classic case of the Emperor's new clothes, this socalled "devolution deal" for Lincolnshire takes power away from people to an additional layer of Mayoral government and guarantees nothing. Our MP's could object and stop it now. Please write to them, to the Minister and to the Prime Minister. Include your address so they know they work for you. Draft letter and petition <u>here.</u> At our public meeting in Bassingham last month, 95% voted against the proposal with two abstentions.

Beckingham Church Clock

North Hykeham Relief Road

The North Hykeham Rellief Road got permission this week. This approx. £200m project is funded with £110m from Government, and the remainder from the County Council, part-funded by new housing developments. Dual carriageway from the A46 to the Eastern Bypass with new or enlarged roundabouts and a flyover at Waddington. Land options were previously secured and will now take place. Six more houses are to be demolished and 200 ha of what is mainly farmland, with some mitigation.



Clean air

Did you know that the air is monitored in our villages by the District Council? The annual mean legal limit of NO2 for health is $40\mu g/m^3$. Our villages have less than 15. Branston is a higher, but less than half the legal limit.
