

### Elections! JULY 4th 2024



As we see a change in Government, colleagues and I at the Local Government Association have prepared a crossparty "White Paper" on what Local Government needs and I am looking forward to working for you with the new ministers.

I was on Sunday Politics East Midlands last week and Radio 4 PM programme on the eve of the election. I spoke about our Independents standing for election. We had 520 Independent candidates and the Independent Network to support them. Independents saw a 70% gain in the May election, just a month ago. On Thursday, we saw six Independents elected to Parliament, for the first time ever in such numbers. We also had some strong seconds around the country.



In Lincolnshire Councils, elected Independents are second in number only to the Conservatives.

Huge thanks to our Lincolnshire Independents standing for what they believe in; Sleaford and North Hykeham, Robert Oates 3,032, in Grantham and Bourne, Charmaine Morgan 1,265 and Independents in Lincoln Laura Ashby 243 and South Holland, Mark le Sage with 5,031. All offered "the only sensible alternative". For Lincolnshire that is 11,610 votes. The incumbants kept their seats except in Lincoln and Boston and Skegness. ## Are you aware of this planning application?

Public meeting on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July 7.30pm at The Venue, Navenby

National Grid are looking to build a power sub station, covering about 30 acres in the first instance; 400MW of lithium ion batteries in 324 shipping containers plus the accessories of more pylons, inverters, concrete etc.

Where? Around 1km north-east of Navenby housing, and over several sites as far as the A15.

You may have heard of the two vast solar industrial sites seeking permission in our area; Springwell adjacent to the A15 and Fosse Green Energy in the Witham Valley, sprawling north from Bassingham. A total of 12,900 acres. That is six times the size of the whole of Navenby Parish which runs from the Brant to the A15.

This solar industry would need a grid connection. If the sub-station goes ahead, so does the solar industry.

The sub station would be about the size of 12 football pitches, like the one built at Bicker Fen, near Boston. Bicker Fen can receive or send electricity to Denmark.



ARE YOU CONCERNED? Many of your Parish Councils and Councillors are too so you are invited to attend a PUBLIC MEETING at THE VENUE, NAVENBY on MONDAY July 8th with a 7.30pm start – the main purpose of the meeting is to ensure as many residents of the cliff villages as possible are aware of the upcoming public consultation for the Navenby substation, currently set for 27 September 2024.

### Water Reservoir – your thoughts?

We councillors had a briefing on the flooding of 2,000 acres of farmland near Sleaford, an area the size of Grafham Water, construction between 2025 and 2030. Anglian Water's plan is to store water en route to 750,000 more houses, mainly in Cambridgeshire. They expect to pump water out of the Trent at Newton on Trent into the Witham, and then out of the Forty Foot Drain by pipe into the reservoir before pumping it off through a new treatment works and on southwards past Bourne and onto Cambridgeshire. ## Making better use of Waste

Currently food goes in the black bin, collected fortnightly and goes to incineration, with the remaining dust going to landfill. The Government now requires us to separately collect food waste every week. It will then go into a biodigester, where bactieria digest it to make methane which is burned to make electricity. Waste material out of the bodigester can be used to fertilise the land or incinerated. The District Councils have been given around £7m for new vehicles and the County Council is asking for just under £10m to create the new facilities.

## **Changes at NKDC**

The Chief Executive, Ian Fytche is leaving at the end of the year after two decades running NKDC. Also the Deputy, Phil Roberts who ran housing, including Lafford Homes, the NKDC wholly-owned development company. I was on the appointment panel for Ian Fytche and remember the decision at a time of working well across different organisations, which he has done. I wish them both well and every success in their new endeavours.

### **Europe and National Work**

I was pleased to speak at the European Councils meeting last month in Brussels on environmental issues and women in politics. There was concern about an increasing influence in Europe of the far right on the European Parliament, but they gained fewer seats than expected.

I chair the steering group on improving civility for the Local Government Association who have produced support for councils. Last month, I gave evidence to the Government Committee on Standards in Public Life.

I was re-elected Vice Chairman of the Local Government Association at our online AGM. And Leader of the Independent Group at that online AGM! Our main conference has moved to October as the election suddenly arrived. We already have a new Chairman as the last one was almost immediately elected to Parliament!

We have 49 Independent Group Council Leaders, who meet fortnightly, but I also have a schedule of visiting them in their own patches, sharing good practice and finding ways to assist, including Kirklees last week.

## Helping Businesses go greener!

NKDC has grants for installing low carbon heating systems and much more. Have a look <u>here</u> for useful webinars on sustainability and marketing with <u>social media</u>.

The **Rural Business Grant** supports businesses to develop new products and facilities that will be of wider benefit to the local economy. The grant will support capital investments only and sustainable investments will be prioritised. The minimum grant is £5,000 with some match funding required. Check if you are eligible. More info can be found here.

The **Small Business Grant** will be used to facilitate growth and expansion of local micro businesses or those that are seeking to relocate to North Kesteven. This fund offers grants of up to 40% of eligible costs, meaning match funding of 60% is required. Grants are available from £500 to a maximum of £5,000, with a minimum project cost of £1,250.
